Golf Outing Formats

Consecutive Tee Times Players: 24 - 32

Reserve a block of time for your group. At your designated start time, foursomes tee off on the 1st tee in consecutive 10-minute intervals. Includes access to Putting Green, Riding Carts (2 players per cart), Ranger Services, and Professional Event Services.

Modified Shotgun Start Players: 36 - 68

At your designated start time, two foursomes per hole will tee off from various starting positions throughout a portion of the course. Includes access to Putting Green, Riding Carts (2 players per cart), Ranger Services, and Professional Event Services.

Full Shotgun Start Players: 72 - 144

The course is ALL yours! At your designated start time, foursomes will tee off from all 18 holes on the course. Includes access to Putting Green, Riding Carts (2 players per cart), Ranger Services, and Professional Event Services.

Food & Beverage

The Caddyshack Grill on site offers a variety of meal options or you may work with an outside caterer.

Cash Bar: Guests are responsible for purchasing their own beverages throughout the entire event.

One beverage cart is included in your golf outing at no cost. An additional cart can be scheduled for \$125

Optional Services

Drink Tickets..... \$5 each

Each guest is given a designated number of drink tickets that can be redeemed for beverages

Outing Checklist

Booking & Registration

- ☐ Review, sign, and submit the Golf Outing Contract Agreement
- ☐ Submit the \$150.00 deposit

Pre-Event Preparations

- ☐ Finalize details and submit final player counts to the golf course **5 days prior** to the event
- ☐ Confirm all catering details with our food and beverage manager ahead of the event. If you're providing your own refreshments, please discuss this with us to ensure compliance with course policies.
- ☐ For a smooth event, **deliver most materials 1-2 days in advance** (signage, banners, tee gifts). Day-of drop-offs are welcome for small items

Day of the Event

- ☐ **Arrival Time:** Event organizers and volunteers should **arrive at least 1-2 hours before the scheduled start time** to oversee setup and address any last-minute details.
- ☐ **Signage and Banners:** Our team will assist in placing all event signage and banners in designated areas. **Please provide clear instructions** or layouts for optimal placement.
- ☐ **Registration Area:** We'll set up tables and chairs for participant **check-in near the '19th Hole'**. Ensure that registration materials, including participant lists and tee gifts, are organized and ready for distribution.
- ☐ **On-Course Setup:** If your event includes on-course activities like contests or sponsored holes, our staff will assist in setting up any necessary equipment or signage at the designated locations.



Helpful Information

Q: How far in advance should I book my golf outing?

A: We recommend booking as early as possible, ideally several months in advance

Q: Can we bring our own food and drinks?

A: Outside catering is allowed, but needs to be approved by our Events, Food, and Beverage Coordinator. Outside liquor is against Illinois law and will not be allowed. Any player or guest in violation of this policy will be asked to discard of any liquor and/or leave the property

Q: Are rental clubs available for players who don't have their own?

A: Yes, we offer several rental club options for men and women starting at \$10.00 per set

Q: What formats are available for golf outings?

A: The most common format for golf outings is the Scramble format, although we do offer Stroke Play, Shamble, Alternate Shot

Q: Can we set up special contests on the course?

A: Yes! We offer Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin, Longest Putt, Hole-in-One Challenges, and our Beat the Pro contest. Other games and contests are welcome but need to be approved by the Superintendent of Golf Services

Q: What happens if there is bad weather on the day of the event?

A: Golf is played in rain, assuming there is no thunder and lightning. If the course is unplayable due to severe weather, we will move your event to the pre-selected rain date listed on the Golf Outing Contract Agreement

Q: What payment methods are accepted at the course?

A: We accept cash, credit card, debit card, and checks. There is NOT an ATM on site, so please plan appropriately.
